M&E in JCM Project: Project Development

Secretariat may: "Monitor the development of JCM related programs and implementation of JCM projects, taking into account sustainable development criteria and environmental integrity." (JCM Rule of Implementation Para 14 point (a) article (iii))

Through:

Project Information Sharing

- The Embassy of Japan and Indonesia JCM Secretariat arrange individual meeting with project participants from both sides.
- The schedule will be arranged in accordance with Japanese participant's visiting schedule.

• JCM Secretariat involvement (if needed)

 If requested, or when obstacles occur (such as location finding or issues related to government systems) the Secretariat should be informed).

M&E in JCM Project: Project Site visit

- Visits are conducted after technology is implemented (project commencing)
- "Monitor the development of JCM related programs and implementation of JCM projects, taking into account sustainable development criteria and environmental integrity." (JCM Rule of Implementation Para 14 point (a) article (iii))
 - At least one site visit by the Indonesia JCM Secretariat (if possible, also by the Japanese side).
 - The purpose of site visit is to receive feedbacks from the Indonesian side and to witness and confirm the technology implementation.
 - If needed, more site visit may be conducted (as agreed by project participant(s) and government side)

M&E in JCM FS

Communication between FS participant and JCM Secretariat

Secretariat may: "Monitor the development of JCM Feasibility Studies activities"

(JCM Rule of Implementation Para 14 point (b) article (ii))

- Annually (usually in February-end of Japanese fiscal year), all FS results from the fiscal year are presented to the Government of Indonesia.
- FS entities strongly recommended to send general development update to Secretariat every 4 months via e-mail.
- If needed, discussion between FS participants and Secretariat is arranged.





Current tools in JCM for Monitoring and Evaluation

- Project monitoring form is used as guideline
- Aspects to be monitored:
 - Technology
 - Site boundary
 - Financing scheme
 - Capacity building
 - Project timeline
- SD criteria implementation plan (under development)
